ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam

Day 4: Angkor Wat and Angkor Thom

- Early morning visit to Angkor Wat for a sunrise experience.
- Explore the intricate details of Angkor Wat and its surroundings.
- Visit Angkor Thom, including the Bayon Temple and Terrace of the Elephants.
Afternoon visit to Ta Prohm, the "Tomb Raider" temple.
- Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 5: Banteay Srei and Departure to Phnom Penh

- Morning visit to Banteay Srei, known for its exquisite carvings.
- Explore Banteay Samre and other lesser-known temples.
- Return to your hotel, check out, and fly to Phnom Penh.
- Arrive in Phnom Penh, check in to your hotel, and rest.
- Overnight in Phnom Penh.

Day 6: Phnom Penh Sightseeing

- Visit the Royal Palace and Silver Pagoda to explore Cambodian architecture.
Reflect on history at the Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum (S-21) and the Killing Fields.
- Enjoy a leisurely walk along the Riverside and perhaps visit the Central Market.
Overnight in Phnom Penh.

Day 7: Departure

- Depending on your departure time, you might have time for some last-minute shopping or exploration.
- Depart from Phnom Penh.
