## ITINERARY

### Day 1: Day 01: - Jaipur Railway Station / Airport – Hotel

### Day 4: Day 04: Bikaner Local Sightseeing – Jaisalmer (330 Km / 6 Hrs)

After breakfast Visit Junagarh fort – it was constructed in the year 1593 by Raja Rai Singh, some of the attractions inside the fort are Anup Mahal, Chandra Mahal, Hawa Mahal, Dungar Mahal, Diwan-e-khas and Ganga Mahal. After that Visit Lalgarh Palace, Sadul Museum. After that transfer to Jaisalmer. On arrival at Hotel Check in and relax. Overnight Stay at Hotel .

### **Day 5: Day 05: Jaisalmer Local Sightseeing**

After breakfast take a full day sightseeing of Jaisalmer. Visit Jaisalmer fort – It is made of sand Stone that's why it is known as sonar Quila. The Jaisalmer Fort is a dominating structure amidst sands. The Jaisalmer city is also known for its old mansions, better known as Havelis. Among many of them you will find Salim ji ki haveli and Nathmal ji ki haveli as the most striking. There are other monuments too, which are equally important because of their distinct and individual architecture. After that Visit Gadisar lake. In the evening Proceed to Visit Sam Sand Dunes. Enjoy Camel Ride and Cultural Activities. Overnight Stay at Hotel.

### **Day 6: Day 06: - Jaisalmer –Jodhpur (330 Km / 6 Hrs)**

After breakfast check out from the hotel and transfer to Jodhpur. Previously Jodhpur was not as Marwar. Jodhpur is the Second Largest city in Rajasthan. The city is known as the "Sun City" because of its bright and sunny weather throughout the year. On arrival at Hotel Check in and relax. Overnight Stay at Hotel.

### **Day 7: Day 07: - Jodhpur Local Sightseeing – Udaipur Via Ranakpur Jain**

Temple (300 Km / 6 Hrs)

After breakfast check out from the hotel and Visit Famous Fort and Palaces of Jodhpur. Visit Mehrangarh fort, Jaswant Thada, Umaid Bhawan Palace. After that transfer to Udaipur. Enroute Visit Ranakpur Jain temple – the main temple is Chaumukh or a four faced temple dedicated to Lord Adinath. There are four subsidiary shrines, twenty -four pillared halls and domes supported by over four hundred columns. The total number of columns is 1,444 all of which are intricately carved with no two being alike. On arrival at Hotel Check in and relax. Overnight Stay at Hotel.

### **Day 8: Day 08: - Udaipur Local Sightseeing**

After breakfast Enjoy full Day Sightseeing of Udaipur. Visit Fateh Sagar Lake, Maharana Pratap Memorial, Sukhadia Circle, Saheliyon ki Bari - Garden of Maids - Beautiful Garden, Bhartiya Lok Kala Museum. Visit City Palace- The Stunning Palace Stands with Proud on the banks of gorgeous Lake Pichola. It is the Largest Palace Complex in Rajasthan. After that Visit Jagdish Temple- World Renowned temple of Lord Vishnu. In the complex the main Jagdish temple is located in the centre surrounded by four smaller temples of Lord Ganesha, Sun God, Goddess Shakti and Lord Shiva. It has 32 steps and 50 pillars, really a brilliant piece of Indian architecture. After that visit Dudh Talai - Dudh Talai is Located Near the bank of Lake Pichola near City Palace Complex. You can use ropeway trolley to visit the hilltop Karni Mata Temple. It is the famous sunset point of Udaipur. Overnight Stay at Hotel.

### **Day 9: Day 09: - Hotel – Udaipur Railway Station / Airport**

After breakfast check out from the hotel and transfer to Udaipur Railway Station / Airport for your onward journey
